



Scanshare Server Data can be exported into a full database backup file and can be imported from this file as well. This guide will step you through those processes.

#### **Backup Server**

Log into the Scanshare as an Administrator Click the "Settings" Menu in the Lower-Left Corner of the Scanshare Interface



Under the "Maintenance" Menu, click "Export/Import"



You will likely need to scroll up at this point to see the Export/Import Options




You are presented with two options, to Export Settings and Workflows to a file or Import Settings and Workflows from a file. You will select "Run export"

This will generate a file named "Scanshare Export.db" and by default will be saved in your Downloads folder.

#### **Restore Server**

Log into the Scanshare as an Administrator Click the "Settings" Menu in the Lower-Left Corner of the Scanshare Interface



Under the "Maintenance" Menu, click "Export/Import"

Next, you will click "Upload" in the lower-right corner




Navigate to your Downloads folder (or wherever your Scanshare Export.db file is located)

### Select file






Click "OK" in the lower-right corner
